The NKSD saga has continued with the superintendent now under a criminal diversion program. Basically, if she does nothing wrong during the term of the program, her record will be expunged. If she does not behave, she will end up in jail for a few months and will have a permanent record. She has not resigned so far.

Candidates/campaigns have been contacting the LD to arrange times to meet our LD members and seek support for their campaigns. These opportunities will be prioritized over other items as necessary. This is the point of our LD: to get Democrats elected to office.
